Mrs. Jennifer Daniels shared about her experience serving with **Union Grove Baptist** in a Good News Club at Clement Elementary. Below is an excerpt of the testimony she shared at the Building Dedication.

“Almost 4 years ago I heard that Clement Elementary had a “Bible Club” and needed some help. After 3 years of service with this club, this past year we saw great harvest! We had 55 children enrolled but averaged 35 in attendance weekly. It has been amazing to be a part of a wonderful team of men, women, and teenagers working together for God’s glory! We were blessed to see 14 students make professions of faith! Even more exciting, **we saw change in the children’s lives!** I loved hearing the stories of how they were excited to share about their faith at dance practice or ball games. We have several young men who are always excited to share their knowledge of God’s Word! To God be the glory!!! I am so thankful for the partnership with local churches, God’s people and CEF to share the Good News in my local public school! What a blessing!”

In Acts 27:11, Paul while under Roman arrest finds himself in a situation that required flexibility. In the midst of a storm when all seemed lost, Paul shared a message from God. He encouraged his fellow travelers not be afraid and work together. His commitment saved the lives of everyone and the gospel was heard by many.

In a *5-Day Club*®, the summer missionaries are stretched to be Spirit led and flexible too. Together they quickly become like “a threefold cord” which is not easily broken. (Ecc. 4:12 ESV) **Together they learn to strengthen their faith in God by walking with him.**

Often, we are faced similar dilemmas. Like Paul, we need to focus on unity (togetherness) and see God’s priority to share the Gospel. God wants to use our lives for his glory.
