CHRISTIAN YOUTH IN ACTION TRAINING BEGINS MARCH 3



AGES 12 - College



CYIA summer missionaries learn how to effectively share the gospel message with children at a nine day training camp in the Asheville area. Following training, CYIA summer missionaries tell the good news of Jesus Christ to local children.

WHAT WILL I DO AT PRE-TRAINING?

CYIA students will be instructed on how to use specific scriptures and the wordless book (as a tool) to share the Gospel. They will become acquainted with the summer lessons, verses, and songs while building friendships with their teammates. Pre-training also includes a fun retreat to Asheville, our annual fundraiser, and the application process. Pre-training is led by experienced students who have served with CYIA for multiple years and love Jesus.

WHAT IS THE STATEWIDE TRAINING CAMP LIKE?

Held at Camp Good News in the beautiful Asheville area, training camp is an awesome opportunity to grow closer to Christ and build godly friendships. Through group sessions and individual study, students will learn how to lead 5-Day Clubs for children, including songs, games, Bible lessons, and a missionary story.

IS THERE ANY COST?

As part of the body of Christ, we encourage CYIA missionaries to invite others to financially partner with them in ministry, specifically through our annual banquet fundraiser.

WHAT COMES AFTER TRAINING CAMP?

An exciting 3 weeks of sharing the Gospel with kids through 5-Day Clubs! It is awesome to work within a team to impact kids in your own local community. Typically a day of service begins around 8:00 a.m. and ends between 3:00-4:00 p.m. Around 8 hours a day should be expected. No clubs are scheduled on the weekends. Please remember that there are a lot of details that have to be considered in planning 5-Day clubs including financial costs, vehicles, drivers (background checked), meals, and coordinating club locations. Because a lot of planning goes into scheduling the 5-Day Clubs, please communicate clearly your availability or any potential conflicts.
