3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to help you keep going and not give up at doing good things. Praise Him for working in you and doing His good work.

Day 1

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths."

—Proverbs 3:6

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Does God have first place in every area of your life? If you believe in Jesus as Savior, pray and ask God to help you give Him first place. Ask Him to use you to do His good work.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

To acknowledge God is to recognize that He is God. He deserves first place in your life. This verse says that God wants you to acknowledge Him in all your ways—in everything you think, say, and do. When you put God first in all your ways, He will show you what decisions you need to make and the way you need to live. He will use you to do His good work!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

—2 Corinthians 12:9

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Praise God for being powerful enough to use you to do His good work. Ask Him to help you trust Him, even in the things you have a hard time doing.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

If you believe in Jesus as Savior, God can use you to do His good work—even if you feel you can't do it. When you think, *I'm really good at this. I don't need any help at all!* You probably won't ask God for help. But God tells you to do things you can't do on your own. When you ask Him for help, you can see God work through you!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

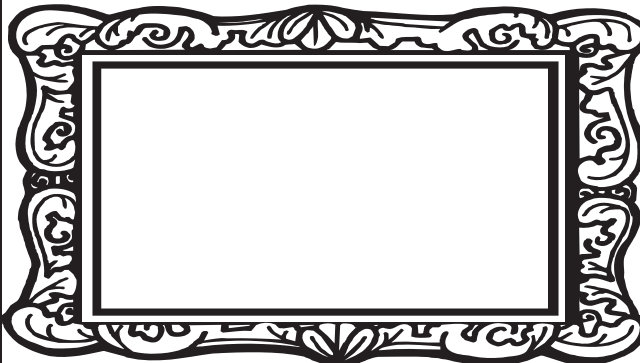
"For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

—Ephesians 2:10

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

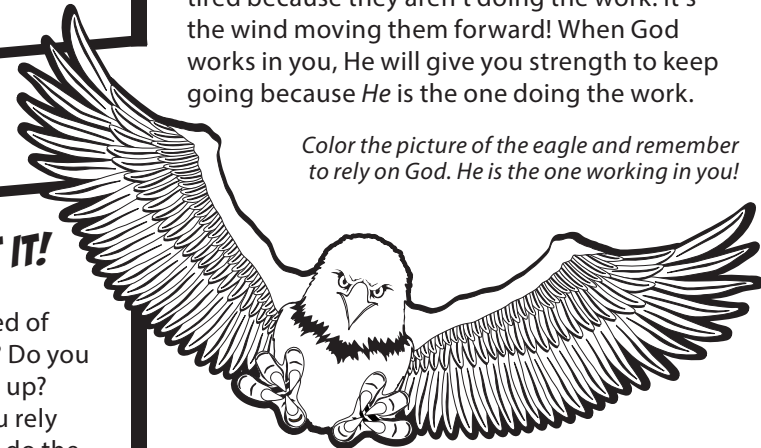
"But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles..."

—Isaiah 40:31

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

This verse does not mean you will grow wings like an eagle. But when you wait for (rely on) God, He promises to give you strength to live His way. Eagles can fly for hours without getting tired because they aren't doing the work. It's the wind moving them forward! When God works in you, He will give you strength to keep going because *He* is the one doing the work.
