—Proverbs 16:9

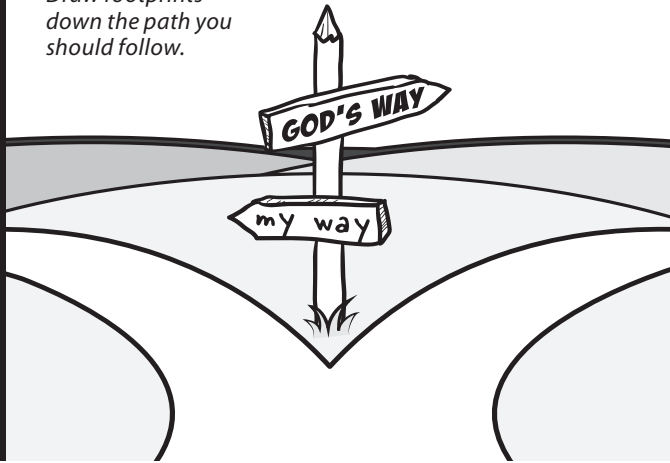
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

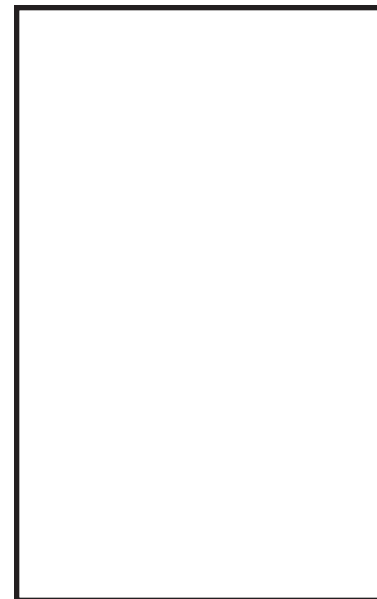
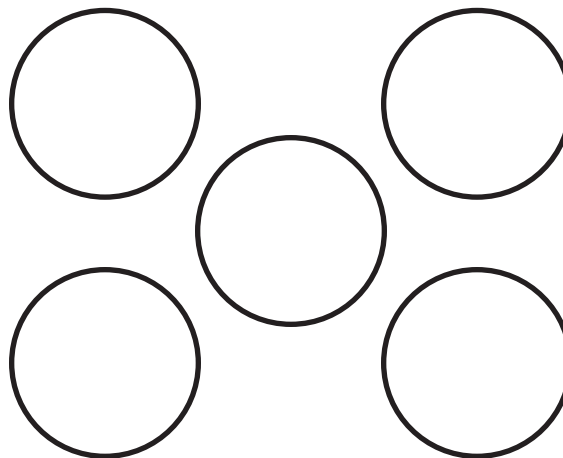
