🙏 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Don't forget to study your memory verse! Read it each day, then try to say it out loud without looking.

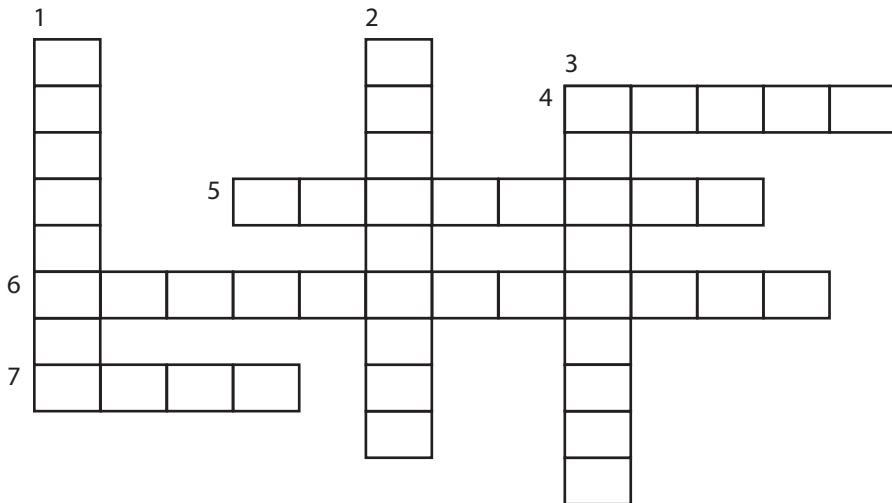

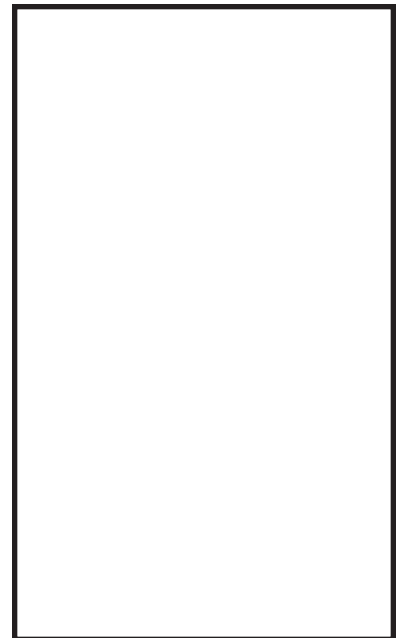
Solve the crossword puzzle using the missing words.

“But you, O 7, are a God 1 and 5, slow to 4 and 3 in 2 love and 6.” **Psalms 86:15**

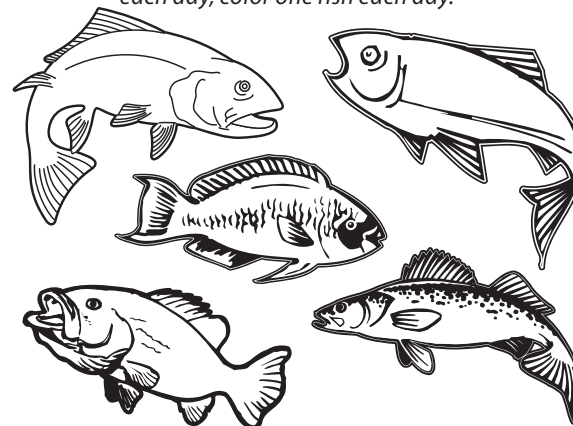
