Say it every day so you learn it by heart!

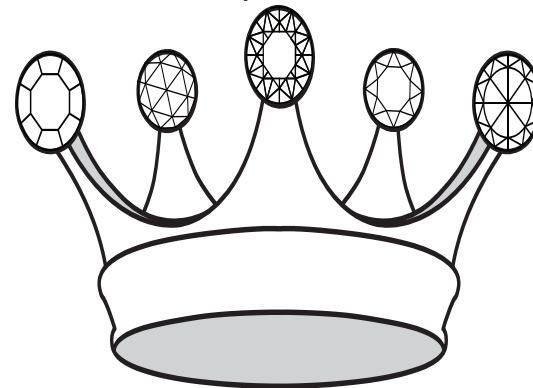

1 READ ABOUT IT!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
