You are reviewing last week's verse this week.

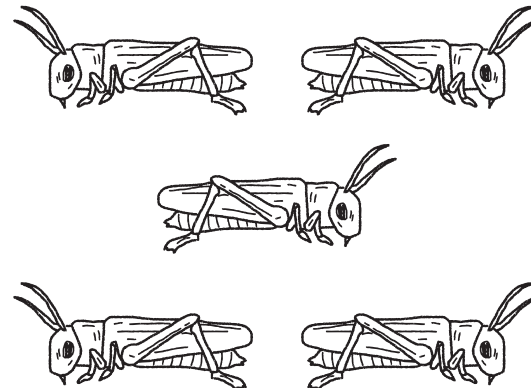
"For it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure."

1 READ ABOUT IT!

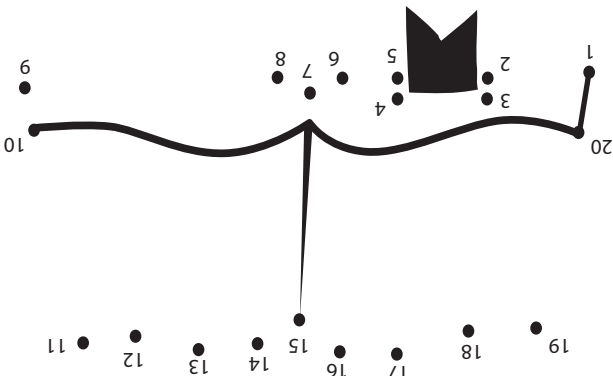
"How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that brings good news..."

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
