

① READ ABOUT IT!

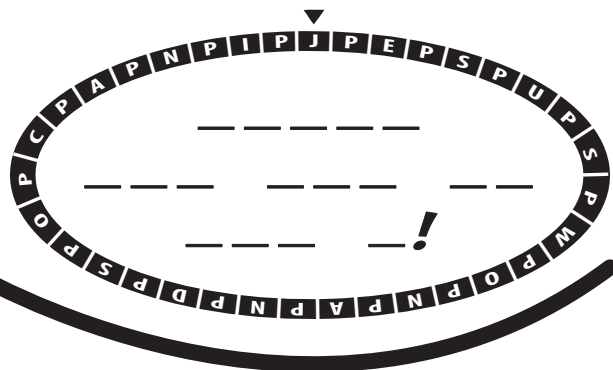

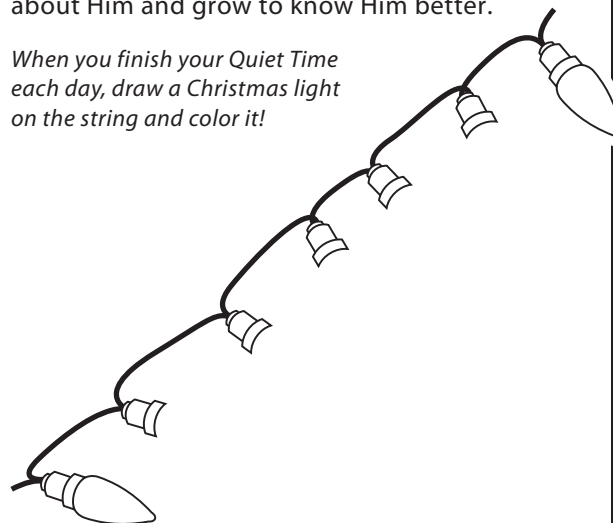

—**Revelation 4:11**

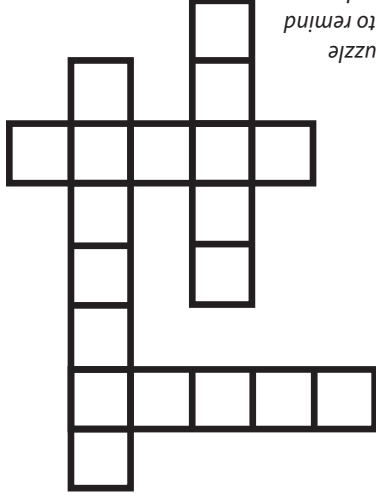
3 **PRAY ABOUT IT!**

—**Proverbs 3:5-6**

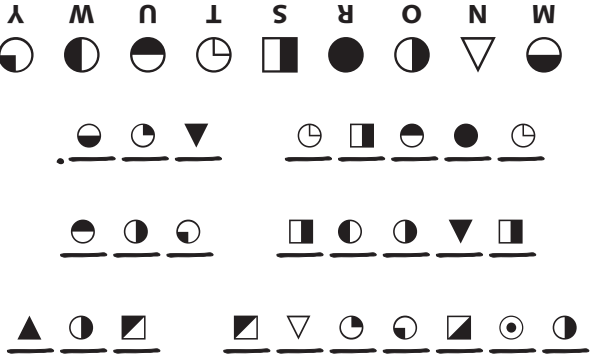
3 **PRAY ABOUT IT!**
