Soon you will be able to say it without looking!

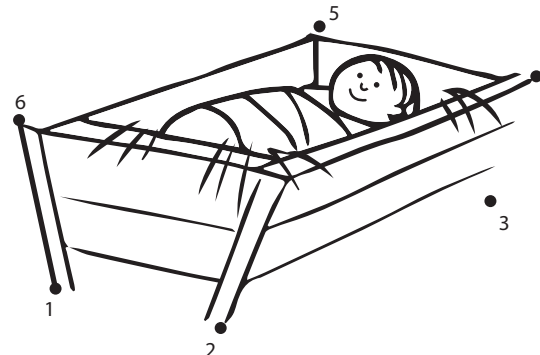
"For unto you is born this day
