3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

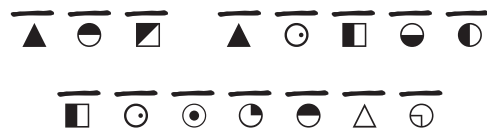
Thank God for the

WORD UP! I can thank God!

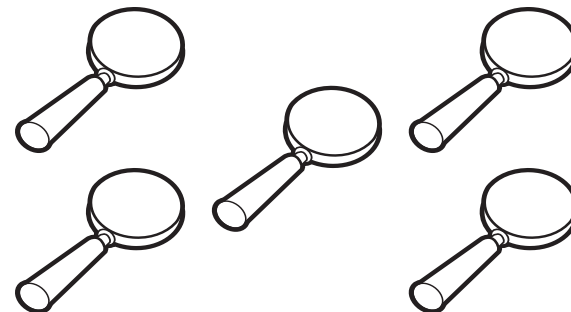
Say the memory verse out loud every day this week.

Day 2

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"Giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for five things right now. Ask Him to help you remember to thank Him throughout the day.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

God has done so many amazing things! The Bible tells us wonderful truths about God, and the world around us shows God's beautiful creation. God is good, loving, merciful, gracious, holy, just, and so much more! When you know the good things God has done, you can give thanks to Him and share the truth about who He is and what He has done!

Take a minute to think of something good God has done and then write it down or draw a picture of it. When you are done, tell someone about it!

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

When someone gives you something good, what should you say? Thank you! God has given you everything you have. You can thank God for the air you breathe, the food you eat, and the shelter you have. God's greatest gift to you is sending Jesus. If you have believed in Jesus, your sins are forgiven and you have a special friendship with God. This is something you can ALWAYS be thankful for, no matter what else is happening in your life.

This verse comes from one of the books of the Bible that was written as a letter. Paul, the person God used to write this part of His Word, the Bible, was writing to believers in Jesus in a city called Rome. Although he was far away from them, he was thanking God for their faith in Jesus. You can also thank God for believers who are living lives that please God! You can thank Him for missionaries, believers you know, and for believers you've never even met who live in other towns and countries.
